

## Speech Bubbles Impact Report 2022-2023 Immediate Theatre

Teacher assessments showed that **83%** of pupils involved in Speech Bubbles improved their emotional behaviour and conduct behaviour skills this year.







Is this child currently reaching age expected targets for reading?




Is this child currently reaching age expected targets for writing?
